# Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup



# RACE HISTORY

It's more than four decades since the Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup was inaugurated at Sha Tin Racecourse. In that time, a host of Hong Kong racing's equine greats have carried off the Gold Cup and today the contest is an international Group 1 race worth HK\$12 million.

The victory roll features standouts such as River Verdon, Indigenous, Bullish Luck, Vengeance Of Rain, Viva Pataca, Ambitious Dragon, Military Attack, Designs On Rome, Werther, Exultant, Time Warp and Golden Sixty. Notable among the race's early winners are Silver Lining, Co-Tack, Gay Eighties and Yuno When, but the distinction of being the first ever Hong Kong Gold Cup winner will forever belong to Observatory, trained by Allan Chan and ridden by the great Pat Eddery, who took the spoils on 14 January, 1979.

That initial contest was an 1800m affair and it was not until 1993 that the race distance changed to its now familiar 2000m. One year earlier the race was granted HKG1 status and formed the second leg of the newly-established Hong Kong Triple Crown, sandwiched between the Stewards' Cup (1600m) and Champions & Chater Cup (2400m). Citi Group has sponsored the Hong Kong Gold Cup since 2008.

River Verdon won the first HKG1 edition in 1992 and proceeded to rattle off a hat-trick of Gold Cup wins - a feat unmatched by any horse to date. His 1993 triumph was the middle leg of a famous Triple Crown triumph, the first and only in Hong Kong racing history.

John Moore is the race's most successful trainer, having won the Hong Kong Gold Cup on 12 occasions, including nine since 2006. Tony Cruz also has nine wins in the race, twice as a jockey and seven as a trainer, including three consecutive editions as Time Warp won in 2018 and 2020, and Exultant triumphed in the 2019 renewal. The race's winning-most riders are Darren Beadman, Basil Marcus, Joao Moreira and Zac Purton with three wins apiece. It was ranked 31st in the IFHA's World's Top 100 G1 Races in 2021.

# CITI HONG KONG GOLD CUP 2021

Golden Sixty extended his unbeaten run to 13 straight wins with victory in the 2021 G1 Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000m) at Sha Tin. The win was both a first in the Gold Cup for trainer Francis Lui and jockey Vincent Ho.

Dropped out to his customary position at the rear of the field, the Medaglia d'Oro gelding began his surge in the straight but the challenge from Furore on the inside required jockey Ho to call on everything that Golden Sixty could give and, it proved just enough in a time of 2m00.25s by a short head, the smallest margin of any of his wins.

"I was quite confident that I would stay ahead of them but we fought hard - it wasn't easy, it was a bit unexpected to be that close. I was just worried about the horse to the inside of him because Golden Sixty laid in a bit, he would have won easier if he didn't do that," Ho said.

"Once he went past Exultant he wanted to lay in - it made it difficult for me but it's still a victory," the 30-year-old added.

"I think you can't really change the horse's character - when he passed the third horse (Exultant), Golden Sixty thinks he has finished the job, but there's another horse on the inside," Lui said.

# RACE HISTORY

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup started out as the Queen's Silver Jubilee Challenge Cup, a 2230m handicap staged at Happy Valley in 1977 to celebrate the Silver Jubilee of Britain's Queen Elizabeth II. The distance and class of the race changed many times throughout the first 20 years until in 1997 it became a mile contest. In 2000, the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup ("Challenge" was dropped from the race title in 1989) was upgraded to HKG3 level; two years later the contest achieved HKG2 status and in 2006 it was further upgraded to HKG1 level. The race distance was shortened to the current distance of 1400m in 2005. The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup was ranked 67th in the list of World's Top 100 G1 races in 2021.

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup is now the second leg of the Hong Kong Speed Series, falling between the G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (first leg - 1200m) and G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (final leg - 1200m). Able Friend produced a sensational win in this race in 2015 that placed the brilliant chestnut at the top of the LONGINES World's Best Racehorse Rankings. Beauty Generation, Hong Kong's Horse of the Year in 2017/18 & 2018/19, completed an unprecedented hat-trick three years in a row (2018, 2019 and 2020). Other past winners of the race include standout champions Ambitious Dragon, Lucky Nine, Good Ba Ba, Electronic Unicorn and the great Silent Witness, who notched his record 17th consecutive career win in this race in 2005. The race's prize money has been increased to the current level of HK\$12 million in 2021.

# QUEEN'S SILVER JUBILEE CUP 2021

Waikuku notched his second elite triumph in the HK\$12 million G1 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup after stalking main rival Southern Legend into the straight before easing to a one and a quarter length margin over Caspar Fownes' charge. Mighty Giant was third.

"He had some interruptions earlier in the season, he had a temperature and he was out of work for quite a while," John Size said.

"Back to 1400m was probably pretty suitable for him with our competition just at present and he likes a fast track, so he was able to run some time.

"So, he had a couple of advantages today that he doesn't normally get so he was able to win the race convincingly." Size added.

"He's such a genuine horse, we know his finish is quite strong. We had a good start, we tracked the right horse. I was confident about my bloke and when I pulled him out in the straight, I knew he was going to be the strongest and he didn't let us down." Joao Moreira said of Waikuku.
